## **Hand Surgery PFET Programme**

## **Information for Training Centres**

The procedures for accreditation to obtain Hand Surgery PFET Centre accreditation involve a formal application to the AHSS PFET Committee and a site inspection.

## The application should include:

- 1. Letter of application which includes a statement that the PFET programme has been read, understood and can be complied with.
- 2. Completion of formal application form, including:
  - a. Duration of the appointment (i.e. is the training period offered for 6 months, 12 months or 18 months?);
  - b. Number of positions available; and
  - c. Possible dates of trainee commencement.

When the application is received, the Training Centre Accreditation (TCA) Sub-Committee will arrange a site inspection and advise of information required to complete the assessment.

Please note that approval as an accredited training centre does not mean the centre must provide a PFET position for any specific period, but simply that the centre is formally accredited.
